Why is my 18-year-old player being required to complete SafeSport?

The SafeSport Act of 2017 is a [Federal Law S.534 — 115th Congress \(2017-2018\)](#)

Due to federal law S.534 The Center for SafeSport was given authority over National Governing Bodies (NGB) to safeguard amateur athletes against abuse. Washington Youth Soccer (WYS) is a organizational member of the NGB US Soccer. As an organizational member WYS is required to follow and enforce the mandated [US Soccer policy 212](#).

Know before you go:

- The full SafeSport training course is available for free if you follow the links provided
- The SafeSport full training can be taken prior to turning 18 with parental consent
- There is no grace period, once they turn 18, they must complete the training before they will be allowed to participate in any WYS sanctioned event and/or activates

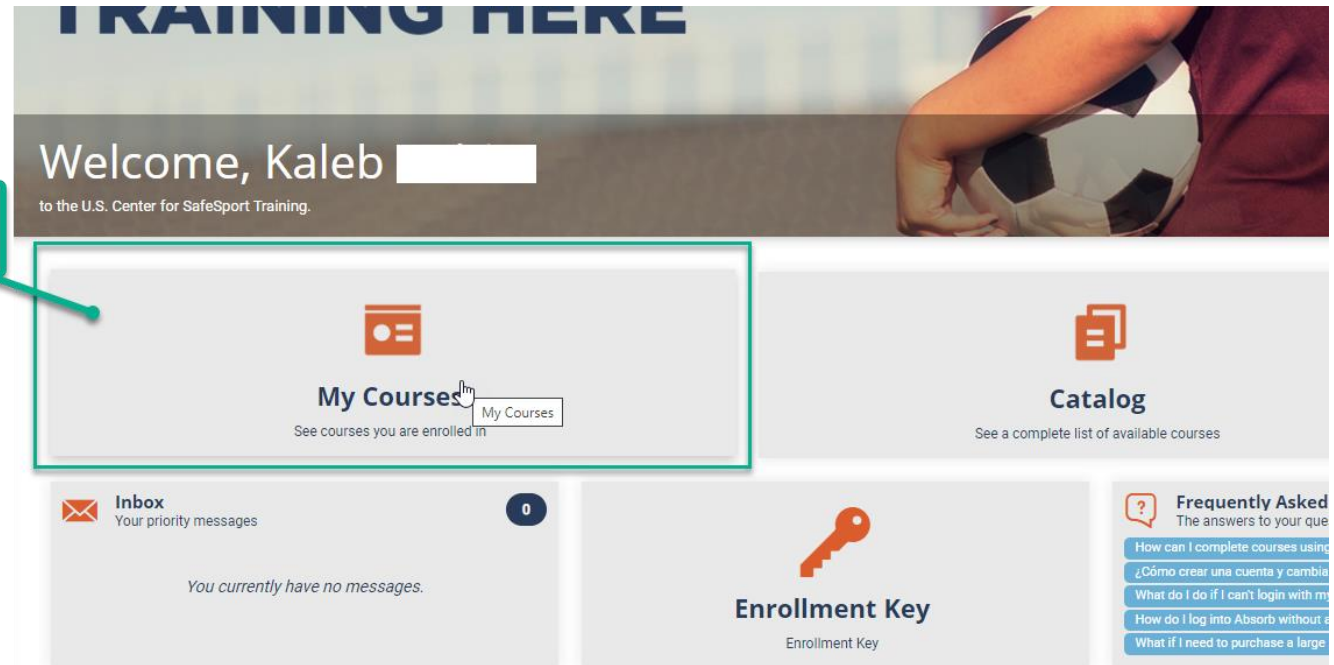

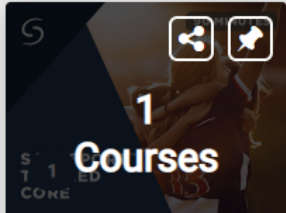
